The Young Investigator Travel Award (YITA) aims to support promising investigators in conducting high-quality research in the field of public health to attend the 54th APACPH Conference in Kuching, Sarawak, MALAYSIA.



Successful applicants will be reimbursed up to USD1000 to cover for:

- Economy-class roundtrip tickets
- Three nights of budget accommodation (must attend the pre-conference workshop)
- Registration fee (waived)



To be eligible for the YITA award, please note the following requirements:

- Faculty member of an APACPH-affiliated institution
- Accepted abstract for oral presentation (applicant must be first author and presenter)
- Full-time graduate student in Public Health or related field OR junior professional/academic with less than 5 years of experience
- Age under 35
